The Jr. Systems Administrator is responsible for the maintenance, monitoring, support, and operation of Keilhauer's computer infrastructure, Local Area Networks (LAN) and Wide Area Networks (WAN). This includes servers, routers, switches, wireless access points and controllers, digital boardroom equipment, VPN, firewalls, data lines, operating systems and other software. Every day, you will perform various checks to make sure the environment is secure and efficient. You will also monitor the IT Helpdesk and provide first and second level technical support for end users at Keilhauer and other supporting companies. The ability to communicate clearly and effectively with both non-technical and technical users is essential. This position is best suited to someone who is excited by the opportunity to work holistically across different areas of IT.

As a worker, you are highly organized, motivated to meet deadlines in a fast-paced environment, and able to assess the proper course of action when technical issues arise. 1. Maintains network infrastructure.

- Monitors existing network hardware and software and offers recommendations where possible.
- Troubleshoots, monitors and implements Internet services.
- Manages Internet usage and activity using Websense Internet Management Software.
- Provides remote office and user connectivity over wireless & VPN solutions.
- Manages all network connectivity (LAN/WAN, wireless, routing) and network infrastructure hardware (Routers, Hubs, Switches, Firewalls, Access Points, Controllers, etc.) using industry-standard best practices.
- Monitors and administers DNS, IIS, WINS, DHCP, VPN, SNMP and SMTP services.
- Monitors and manages Keilhauer's Spiceworks Asset and Helpdesk management system.
- Reduces the amount of virus infections on the network via email, Internet, USB, etc., and properly cleans any infected systems on the network.
- Implements network security to provide a stable and secure networking platform and prevent external intrusions as well as internal threats.
- Rapidly troubleshoots network outages.

2. Maintains server infrastructure and services.

- Prevents data loss due to temporary power outages/failures/brownouts.
- Effectively manages equipment life cycles and gives input regarding annual budget.

- Troubleshoots Windows operating systems including: 2008/2012/2016, Windows 7 Pro, Windows 7 Embedded, and Windows 10.
- Coordinates installation and/or relocation of local and remote systems, including data cabling.
- Assists in the installation of hardware and software systems.
- Administers WYSE Thin Clients, Images and Device Manager.
- Assists end users in diagnosing and solving all computer hardware, software, and printer problems.
- Ensure that all End User Workstations and Thin Clients are functioning at maximum performance by administering complete hardware and software diagnostics as required.
- 3. Contributes to improvement projects within the IT environment wherever needed.
 - Prepares progress reports for Technical Services Manager on project status and progress towards goals.
 - Recommends additions and changes to information system standards, policies and procedures.
 - Creates, modifies and maintains Keilhauer product configuration models which are used to build customer orders through Keilhauer's ERP system (SyteLine).
 - Manages the Electronics/Computer Recycling Program as well as inkjet and toner recycling.
 - Researches, recommends, and assists in the decision making of hardware and software solutions based on project requirements and future network infrastructure additions/changes.
 - Prepares, recommends, and applies additions and changes to information system standards, policies and standard operating procedures.
